MAN A READY FORCE

ASR Purpose


To increase the number of medical, dental and physician assistant student accessions into the Army National Guard by placing up to 600 of these students on ADOS recruiting status while they complete their educational programs.



MAN A READY FORCE

ASR Overview (1 of 4)


- **Eligibility:** Newly accessed Medical/Dental/PA Students or individuals w/ a letter of acceptance as a full time student from an accredited medical, dental, or physician assistance school who will graduate with a masters in PA studies (includes current ARNG soldiers)
(must be a US citizen or Nationalized US citizen)
 - Oathed into the ARNG Medical Services Corps on or after 1 APR 08 – upon completion of medical school, dental school or physician assistant school, the officer will be reappointed as a MC/DC or SP Corps Officer



MAN A READY FORCE

ASR Overview (2 of 4)

- **Orders:** Up to 1,094 days (3 years)
 - T-32 ADOS, (Active Duty Operational Support)
 - Managed through use of control numbers managed by National Guard Bureau (NGB-ASM)
 - ASM will maintain historical records for all ASR participants



MAN A READY FORCE

ASR Overview (3 of 4)

- **Command/Control:** State Officer Strength Manager
 - Monitor leave/passes
 - Mission production
 - Issues with pay and allowances
- **Enrollment:** max 200 new participants Nationally per Year
 - Bi-annual enrollment cycles and orders, 1 JAN and 1 JUL
 - Control number requested following USAREC boarding
 - Payment processing submitted when enrollment packet submitted
 - First Come basis



MAN A READY FORCE



ASR Overview (4 of 4)

- **Obligation:**
 - contractual service obligation year for year post graduation
 - ASM will maintain a historical database for state reference
 - ASRs will be released from their MSO (military service obligation) should ADOS funding not be available upon student enrollment into ADOS
- **Mission Credit:** Awarded to the recruiter processing new accessions through DCA
- MDSSP (medical/dental student stipend) of \$ 22,884 per year can not be taken in conjunction with this program

ASR Duties & Responsibilities (1 of 2)

- Missioned to recruit medical/dental/PA students based upon the NGB and state/territory mission agreement
- Responsible for bi-monthly reporting to the state/territory ASR manager of all leads and duties performed
- Serves as a local ARNG recruiting liaison and POC within their respective degree program under guidance of the State RRC/OSM
- Maintain tri-fold brochures within their school
- Participate in local student society organizations representing the ARNG and enhance the knowledge of the ARNG programs



MAN A READY FORCE



ASR Duties & Responsibilities (2 of 2)

- Available to the State OSM to assist in school presentations
- Attend all courses and training required to complete their specified degree
- Participate in all ARNG unit level training and drill exercises IAW the approved Flexible Training Policy dated 1 September 2006
- Attend annual ASR training
- Perform additional recruiting duties as assigned

Financial Incentives (1 of 2)

- 2LT Pay w/ under 2 yrs of service:

- \$ 2,555.70 monthly pay
- \$ 1,024 BAH w/ dependents (basic allowance for housing), non-taxable per month
- \$ 853. with out dependents, non-taxable (based on school location – Erie, Pa.)
- \$ 202.76 BAS (basic allowance for subsistence), non-taxable

Financial Incentives (2 of 2)

- 2LT Pay w/ under 2 yrs of service:

- \$ 2,555.70 monthly pay
- \$ 1,024 BAH w/ dependents
- \$ 202.76 BAS
- \$ 90,779.04 total pay for 1st & 2nd year
- \$ 54,958.32 total pay for 3rd year as a 1LT w/BAH & dependents, BAS, w/ over 2 yrs of service
- \$ 145,737.36 = Total ADOS Pay over 3 yrs
