10 a. SUPPORTS both financial and categorical Medicaid eligibility expansion;

11 b. OPPOSES Medicaid eligibility restrictions including **but not limited to:** enrollment
12 caps, proof of citizenship status, **drug testing** or other administrative barriers to eligibility;

13 c. SUPPORTS simplification of enrollment and renewal procedures for Medicaid and
14 SCHIP programs. (2010)
