SUBJECT: Principles Regarding Service in Underserved Areas and Service Obligations

TYPE: **Resolution of Principles** 

WHEREAS, loan forgiveness programs are in place to lift the burden of debt for primary care physicians,

WHEREAS, there are restrictions on how forgiveness programs can relieve loan debt,

WHEREAS, some physicians in training may have more medical school tuition, and thus may have more debt than their colleagues,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Principles Regarding Service in Underserved Areas and Service Obligations (p. 26-27) be AMENDED by addition to state:

8. In regard to public service loan forgiveness:

SUPPORTS the public service loan forgiveness program, and the adoption of eligibility criteria, and defines full time internship and residency training at an eligible non- profit institution as a public service. (2011)

OPPOSES the consideration of the sum amount of loan forgiveness as taxable income (2016)

OPPOSES a cap on the amount of loan forgiveness (2016)
