SUBJECT: Principles regarding reproductive rights, family planning and sex education

TYPE: Resolution of Principles

WHEREAS there is no explicit mention of sexual assault or rape culture under sexual education

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the principles regarding reproductive rights, family planning and sex education (p.53) be AMENDED BY ADDITION to state:

5. In regards to sex education:

L. STRONGLY URGES that sex education include discussion on rape culture in which rape is defined as sex that is forced, coerced, given without sober consent, or not between consenting adults.
