WHEREAS there are bills promoting the remains of an abortion to be cremated or buried.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the principles regarding reproductive rights, family planning and sex education (p.52) be AMENDED to state:

J. Regarding clinic violence, AMSA:

1. SUPPORTS a woman's right to an abortion performed in a safe and secure environment;
2. **OPPOSES** the any law that would require fetal remains, from a miscarriage or abortion to be buried or cremated.
3. CONDEMNS the violence directed against abortion clinics and family planning centers as a violation of the right of access to health care.
