WHEREAS AMSA has not as of yet established a position on the use of Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) for the prevention of HIV/AIDS;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Principles Regarding Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) and HIV-Related Illnesses (p. 106-111) be AMENDED BY ADDITION to state:

1. In regard to infection control policies:

a. SUPPORTS and URGES the following measures to control the spread of infectious diseases in every health-care facility in the United States:

v. AMSA SUPPORTS the use of PrEP for the prevention of HIV transmission, particularly in individuals at high risk of infection (as defined by CDC Clinical Practice Guidelines).
