SUBJECT:	Amendment to Principles Regarding Preventative Medicine and Public Health
TYPE:	Resolution of Principles

WHEREAS the Zika Virus is rapidly spreading among the Americas due to the habits and geography of its host mosquito species [1]; and

WHEREAS residence in, as well as travel to and from, endemic and epidemic areas will affect significant numbers of patients; and

WHEREAS several of the now epidemic country outbreaks will be sites of worldwide and regional events; and

WHEREAS the increasing territory of Zika poses a threat to several portions of the U.S., potentially aided through climate change by vector spread; and

WHEREAS the adult, gestational and developmental effects of Zika pose a substantial public health threat; and

WHEREAS preventive measures for infection of Zika virus have spillover benefits for other similarly transmitted and related diseases;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Principles Regarding Preventative Medicine and Public Health (p. 83) be AMENDED BY ADDITION to state:

14. SUPPORTS taking steps to appraise members and the public of resources available to help prevent and recognize infection and transmission of the Zika virus;
