SUBJECT:	Principles Regarding Primary Care and Family Medicine
ТҮРЕ:	Resolution of Principles

WHEREAS the current language within the Preamble, Purposes, Principles (PPP) is outdated; and,

WHEREAS primary care training already exists within the Ob/Gyn residency program; and,

WHEREAS the American Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG) believes that "preventive counseling and health education are essential and integral parts of the practice of obstetricians and gynecologists as they advance the individual and community-based health of women of all ages" [1].

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Principles Regarding Primary Care and Family Medicine (p. 31-32) be AMENDED to state:

In regard to Ob/Gyn and Primary Care:

a. RECOGNIZES the important role that obstetrician-gynecologists play in the primary care of women, and, therefore, ENCOURAGES the development SUPPORTS the continuation of primary care training within existing ob/gyn residency programs that emphasizes curricula in comprehensive care, continuity of care, appropriate referral, and psychosocial and behavioral components of sexual and reproductive medicine to prepare obstetrician-gynecologists to meet fully the needs of the patients they serve;
