THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Constitution and Bylaws, Article III be amended to read:

Professional member: Available to any physician who has completed medical training and has demonstrated a serious interest in the objectives of the organization. Lifetime professional membership is conferred upon all National Presidents and Student Office Fellows.

Graduate member: Available to any person currently engaged in graduate medical education in the U.S. (e.g. current residents and fellows).

All National Presidents and Student Office Fellows shall be given lifetime membership in the organization in the category that is appropriate to their level of training or relationship to the organization at any given time.
