SUBJECT:	Amendment to Principles Regarding The Use of Illegal Drugs, Alcohol and Tobacco
TYPE:	Resolution of Principles

WHEREAS the definition of tobacco products is expanding; and

WHEREAS new products are being released containing liquid nicotine; and

WHEREAS there is increasing awareness with regard to risks of nicotine and nicotine delivery products; and

WHEREAS specific language in the PPP references old initiatives and needs to be updated;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Principles Regarding the Use of Illegal Drugs, Alcohol and Tobacco (p. 46-50) be AMENDED that:

All occurrences of the word "tobacco" be AMENDED BY SUBSTITUTION to state "tobacco, tobacco derivative and nicotine delivery products" as listed in sections 6.A, 7.A, 7.C, 7.E, 7.F, 7.G, 7.H, 7.J, 9.A, 9.B, 9.E, 14, 15, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, ; and

All occurrences of the word "cigarette" be AMENDED BY SUBSTITUTION to state "tobacco, tobacco derivative and nicotine delivery products" as listed in sections 6.A, 6.B, 7.B, 10; and

be further AMENDED BY ADDITION AND/OR SUBTRACTION to state:

- 3. Regarding health and treatment:
  - g. Supports equitable access to cessation services and treatment for tobacco, tobacco derivative and nicotine delivery product use, especially for minors.

6. In regard to preventative issues:

d. SUPPORTS the goal of the Surgeon General and of Healthy People 2010 to reduce the rate of smoking in America by 2010 to only 12% of adults and 16% of teenagers

7. In regard to marketing and advertising:

k. SUPPORTS a federal regulation requiring licensure for the sale of tobacco, tobacco derivative and nicotine delivery products increasing the legal age for tobacco purchase in all states to 18 21 years old and local enforcement of this age limit by requiring proof of identification. AMSA further SUPPORTS fines for vendors who do not comply and revocation of tobacco licenses upon multiple violations.

- m. SUPPORTS requiring all tobacco, tobacco derivative, and nicotine delivery products be sold in child resistant
  packaging.
- 16. BELIEVES that out of mutual professional courtesy and respect, physicians and medical students should not smoke
  use tobacco, tobacco derivative, and nicotine delivery products at professional meetings;
