WHEREAS The current language within the Preamble, Purposes, Principles (PPP) reflects examinations that are no longer used; and,

WHEREAS Internationally trained medical graduates must be certified by the Educational Commission For Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) before being able to practice in the United States; and,

WHEREAS Other sections of the PPP address sources of graduate medical education funding in greater detail.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Principles Regarding International Medical Schools and Graduates (p. 36) be AMENDED to state:

3. SUPPORTS continued graduate medical education funding through Medicare for those graduates of international medical schools who have passed both parts of the International Medical Graduate Examination in the Medical Sciences been certified by the Educational Commission For Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG);
