1 WHEREAS AMSA firmly supports equal access to equally high standards of healthcare, advocacy, and patient education

4 WHEREAS AMSA seeks to base sex education on increasing knowledge of the unique health needs specific to
5 adolescents, including lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender youth (p. 53); and

9 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Principles Regarding Reproductive Rights, Family Planning and Sex
10 Education (p. 51) be AMMENDED BY ADDITION to state:
