WHEREAS the American Medical Student Association must adhere to its Constitution, Bylaws and Internal Affairs documents;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Internal Affairs Section XXIII shall be amended to strike Line 12:

12. The magazine shall not be used by the organization and any subgroup of the organization or any group external to the organization for the purpose of pursuing or presenting, in any format, issues of special interest.
