 - Support the Graduate Caucus and alumni participation in Association programming.
 - Develop strategies to improve the alumni and resident membership experience.
 - Ensure continuity of communication with alumni and resident members of the Association.
- 3. Architect, Alumni Engagement Program Employs project planning and evaluation skills to:
 - Build the alumni and resident networks as part of the Alumni Engagement Program.
 - Work with staff to develop and execute the Alumni Engagement Program.

Expectations & Accountability

- 1. The leadership term is two years and begins on May 1, 2016 until April 30, 2018.
