ACROSS

2. Spontaneous loss of a pregnancy before the fetus is usually viable outside the uterus.
4. A life-threatening pregnancy that develops outside the uterus, often in a fallopian tube.
7. The moment during pregnancy when a pregnant person first notices the fetus moving in their uterus.
8. A term used to describe a person whose gender identity is different from the sex they were assigned at birth.
12. A medical intervention provided to individuals who need to end the medical condition of pregnancy.

DOWN

1. A permanent birth control method for males. In this procedure, a portion of the tube that carries sperm is removed.
3. The gestational stage medically begins at implantation, during which a person carries a growing fetus in their uterus.
5. Devices, medicines or procedures used to prevent pregnancies, with the beginning of pregnancy defined as implantation.
6. The stage of pregnancy when the blastocyst attaches to the wall of the uterus.
9. The stage of development that starts at fertilization (joining of an egg and sperm).
10. A person who gives emotional support during pregnancy, labor, and childbirth and for some time after.
11. The stage of human development beyond eight completed weeks after fertilization. This is the stage after pregnancy has begun. Medically, the beginning of pregnancy is called implantation.

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
